

Epicurean Luxury in Tuscany

Enjoy 3 days in some of the most luxurious Estate in Tuscany: savour the flavours of their restaurants with the artistic touch of their Michelin rated Chefs, visit ancient cellars, taste impressive wines and relax in gorgeous SPA, all complemented by beautiful landscapes and suggestive excursions.



Day 1 – ARRIVAL

- Private transfer from airport to hotel.
- Check-in at the hotel: **an enchanting 5*L boutique** hotel where nature meets luxury. A working organic farm, vineyards, 13-acre gardens and an artistic pavilion on the banks of a pond, in addition to prestigious restaurants and extraordinarily decorated rooms: a fairy tale location with 5 stars services.
- After check-in enjoy a horseback ride through the gentle hills around the property or a nice stroll to discover the many secrets of the Estate.
- A welcome lunch in a out of the ordinary setting: built around two giant spreading oak trees and overlooking sweeping views of the surrounding Valley, the Trattoria, Brasserie & Bar evokes the feeling of dining in an immense treehouse. The menu is a showcase of their 'farm to plate' philosophy, with 0km meat, fresh cheese and vegetables, free-range eggs and prosciutto sourced from the estate
- In the afternoon go to visit the impressive San Galgano Abbey & the Sword in the stone, where beauty meets legend: the abbey ruins, with no windows or roof, have a very magical atmosphere. At 5 minutes walk from the abbey you can see the church and the Chapel that were built up around the spot where San Galgano stuck his sword in a stone and where is still visible the sword itself in the rock.
- After an "aperitivo/wine tasting" in the cellar of the Estate that includes more than 1200 prestigious labels, enjoy a tasting dinner in their Michelin rated restaurant: by collaborating with the estate's farmers and culinary gardeners, the Chef is able to craft highly personalized gourmet dishes using tailor-made, certified organic ingredient.
- Overnight at the Estate

Day 2 – MONTALCINO & BRUNELLO WINE

- Breakfast at the hotel
- After checkout, transfer to **Montalcino area**, famous all over the world for its renowned Brunello wine and enjoy a wine tour and tasting in one of the world's most beautiful wine estates. You will immerse yourselves in the beauty of this authentic corner of Tuscany, a setting of unparalleled elegance and refinement, while enjoying a selection of the estate's top wines guided by experienced staff: a unique and exclusive wine experience in Tuscany.
- After lunch check in at the hotel: **a 5* Resort & SPA** set in an amazing noble villa, originally built as a renaissance palace for the Grand Duke Ferdinando I de' Medici. The resort overlooks the majestic rolling hills of Val d'Orcia, and is set atop a natural hot springs to fully utilize the power of the thermal waters, with its collection of panoramic pools, hot tubs and treatment facilities.
- In the afternoon enjoy the thermal spa and the many treatments of the Resort overlooking an unparalleled landscape
- In the evening, transfer to a beautiful medieval hamlet dominated by a 11th century Castle, steeped in history and charme, where is set a little restaurant that reserves many surprises, first of all the virtuosity of the stellar young Chef: his creations are a concentrate of beauty and a symphony of colors and flavours.
- Overnight at the hotel

Day 3 – VAL D'ORCIA E PIENZA

- Breakfast at the hotel
- After check-out, go to visit Sant'Antimo Abbey, passing through the enchanting landscapes of the Val d'Orcia, famous as **UNESCO World Heritage Site** (as artistic, natural cultural landscape) and well known also for its product such as Olive Oil and Cheese.
- Arrive in a tiny and exquisite mediaeval village with narrow streets, distant views and an intriguing square with a massive 750-year old well, nestling under an imposing fortress. In this lovely setting, enjoy your lunch in an exquisite Osteria that has just gained its first Michel Star: a tasting lunch that won't leave you indifferent.
- After lunch visit some pretty villages of the Val d'Orcia, such as Castiglion d'Orcia and Bagno Vignoni before arriving to Pienza, famous for its Pecorino cheese where taste it and shop it for a delicious closure of this Tuscan trip.
